ADMISSION POLICY

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1. General provisions

Mission: Throughout education we nurture open-minded inquirers who strive to make the world better.

Vision: Empower students with the skills and knowledge to handle the challenges in both local and global communities.

1. This policy defines the admission procedure for the International Baccalaureate “Diploma” Programme of the NPUA Yerevan High School.

1.1. Students at the age of 16 to 19 are admitted to NPUA Yerevan High School IB “Diploma” Programme with all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities typically given or made available to students at the school, regardless of their race, color, national or ethnic origin or ancestry, religion, sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity. It does not discriminate based on race, color, national/ethnic origin or ancestry, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, or any other consideration protected by state or local laws. In the administration of its educational policies, admission policies, scholarship and loan programs, and other school- managed programs, it does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national/ethnic origin or ancestry, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or any other consideration protected by state or local laws.

1.2. The Admission Committee at NPUA Yerevan High School undertakes to ensure proper consultation of applicants and their parents during the admission.

1.3. The school adheres to the policy of open and inclusive admission, encouraging the admission of applicants with different abilities, talents and opportunities. From our point of view, the most important factors in the admission process are the students conscious choice of our school. The school is responsible for



providing applicants with a chance of success in the proposed courses. To this end, the school has established the fundamental requirements for the International Baccalaureate “Diploma” Programme.

- 1.4. The school is also committed to ensuring that applicants submit online applications and, if necessary, take the entrance exam online.
- 1.5. The school carries out the admission to the “Diploma” Programme of the International Baccalaureate in accordance with the number of places approved by the Academic Council of the University for the given academic year in accordance with the number of places with the “Diploma” Programme.

2. Qualified applicant

2. Candidates can apply for the school's International Baccalaureate “Diploma” Programme and participate in the entrance exams, who:

- 2.1. are citizens of the Republic of Armenia, 16-19 years old and have completed the 10th grade,
- 2.2. are a foreign country citizens, 16-19 years old and are about to apply to a two-year High school program,
- 2.3. IBDP students who will be transferred from other IB World Schools to continue their education at the “Diploma” Programme of NPUA Yerevan High School and will successfully pass the necessary exams for transfer, which will be determined according to the subjects offered, in accordance with the established procedures.

3. Documentation

3. The applicant, and in the case of a minor, together with a legal representative



(parent, adoptive parent or trustee) also submits the following documents to the Admission Center of the NPUA (admission committee):

1. an application,
2. 4 photos (3x4),
3. the original or a copy of the 9th grade graduation certificate,
4. the original or a copy of the 10th grade final grades,
5. an identity document (passport or birth certificate),
6. copies of parents' passports,
7. social service number,
8. a document confirming the citizenship of another country,
9. 10000 AMD application fee. Regardless of participation in the competition and the result of admission, the amount paid will not be refunded to the applicant,
10. appropriate medical documentation in case of special educational needs,
11. list of per-selected subjects,
12. motivation letter,
13. valid and official results of any of the TOEFL iBT, IELTS Academic exams, if available.

4. Admission Center

4. The NPUA Admission Center publishes a statement on admission conditions, which includes applicant documents admission form and admission conditions and a list of offered subjects. Subject commissions are formed to organize the process of checking applicants' knowledge. The Coordinator of the diploma program submits a list of submitted subject commissions to the Admission Center.

The main person to cooperate with the Admission Center (admission committee) during the whole admission process is the IBDP Coordinator.



4.1. The Admission Center offers the following:

- 4.1.1. provide applicants with the necessary information about the high school, as well as about the “Diploma” Programme,
- 4.1.2. recommendations on the correct choice of the offered subjects,
- 4.1.3. consultation on filling out the admission application,
- 4.1.4. providing information about the schedule and venue of the entrance exams,
- 4.1.5. Information on the organization of the applicants' appeal process,
- 4.1.6. publication of data on applicants who have overcome admission.

4.2. Chairman of the Knowledge Verification Committee:

- 4.2.1. organizes the development and preparation of the test necessary to test knowledge,
- 4.2.2. together with “Diploma” Programme Coordinator signs and converts the packages necessary for testing knowledge, which are deposited with the executive secretary of the admission committee,
- 4.2.3. manages the knowledge examination process and is responsible for the quality of the committee's work.

4.3. The applicant must:

- 4.3.1. Fill out the application form at the NPUA Admission Center.
- 4.3.2. Pass knowledge test in Mathematics and English. Tests for Mathematics are available in English and Armenian versions.
- 4.3.3. Provide valid and official certificates of any of the TOEFL iBT, IELTS Academic exams, if available. The passing score for TOEFL iBT is 70 points, and for IELTS Academic - 5.5 points.
- 4.3.4. Participate in subject-based interviews on selected subjects.
- 4.3.5. Participate in an interview with parents.



5. Regulations

5. Applicants who have passed the minimum examination threshold will participate in the admission competition, which will be held in accordance with the places provided for this academic year. Applicants who have won the competition will participate in the subject interview stage.

- 5.1. For applicants who will be transferred from the other “Diploma” Programme International Baccalaureate schools knowledge assessment will be carried out from the selected subjects.
- 5.2. Citizens of the Republic of Armenia who have completed the IBDP programme, and successfully passed NPUA Yerevan High School final exams, in accordance with the Law of the Republic of Armenia "On General Education", can receive a state certificate of secondary education of the Republic of Armenia.

6. Admission

6. Admission is carried out in accordance with the passing scores and places provided for this academic year.

- 6.1. In case of equal points, according to the established order, the advantage is given to:
 - 6.1.1. An applicant who has received a diploma in categories at the republican subject Olympiads for schoolchildren in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English and other subjects.
 - 6.1.2. An applicant who completed the 10th grade with honors (submit a certification document).



- 6.1.3. An applicant who got the highest scores in the subjects of the 9th grade final examinations in order of primary sequence (Mathematics, English).
- 6.2. The examination of applicants' knowledge is carried out according to a 7-point system, the minimum positive threshold is 4 points. Applicants with a positive assessment participate in the competition for admission.
- 6.3. The Admission Center publishes the results of the applicants' knowledge test and admission competition (on the university's official website) within three working days after the deadline for the knowledge test in the specified subjects.
- 6.4. From 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. the day after the publication of the admission competition, Applicants, can submit an application-complaint online (at ibdp@polytechnic.am e-mail address) or to the admission committee in written form, to which they will receive an answer within 1 working day.
- 6.5. The contract is concluded with the candidates who have successfully passed the competition and their parents (legal representative).
