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Core elements:

- Extended Essay (EE)
- Theory of Knowledge (TOK)
- Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS)

The two alternatives below are available to students when choosing their six subjects for a diploma:

1. 4 subjects at the high level (HL) and 2 at the standard level (SL).
2. 3 SL subjects and 3 HL subjects

All Higher Level (HL) subjects must be taught over the two-year duration of the program, while also meeting the requirements of the core subjects during the same timeframe. HL courses typically involve more in-depth content and require more teaching hours, totaling 240 hours. Standard Level (SL) courses entail approximately 150 teaching hours.
